I.G.E.S., founded in 1987 by a group of Italian academics, organizes training courses, seminars and conferences dealing with issues related to human rights, international humanitarian law, post conflict analysis and researches and human dignity. It is possible to remind the role of I.G.E.S. in the organization in 1990 of an international seminar held in Trieste and Gorizia on *“The contemporary evolution of human rights”* in cooperation with UNHCR and the organization of a number of seminars and conferences dealing with human rights and non-discrimination issues from 1991 to 2006; Finally it seems to be relevant also the commitment of the association in the ESF training activities in the Region Friuli Venezia Giulia from 1997 to 2005.

I.G.E.S. cooperates with team of 4 academics and researchers in juridical and economic issues who deal with the association as collaborators. The association is also owner of a significant library with over 2.000 volumes (EU and International law, economy, sociology, politics). Since 1990 the institute cooperates with the Faculty of Political Sciences of the University of Trieste in different juridical, sociological and economical research programmes.
